NEPTUNE BASE

QUEER STORIES

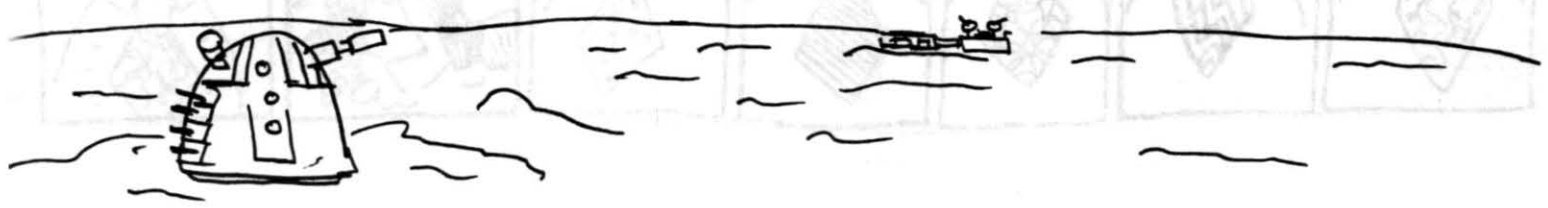
I began writing "Neptune Base" in the fifth grade, although it has improved a lot over the years. I have tried to make it neither a Star Wars style, where the thing they seem to do the most is shoot up people (although next month's story will come close), nor a case of spies and infiltration, which isn't really possible on such a closed world, but simply some action and adventure without those two.

Neptune may be slightly different in the stories than it is in real life. It has a temperature range of 100 to 170 degrees Kelvin (-170 to -100 C), and oxygen can be a solid, liquid, or even a gas at those temperatures, depending on whether the planet is facing the sun at the time. The atmosphere is one-fifth as dense as ours, but the gravity is five times as much. Both are great hazards to spacecraft, who are sometimes pulled into the planet and can overheat in the atmosphere (which always has a little oxygen because the rotation only takes 18 hours). There is a big difference between seasons, but Neptune Base is near the equator so it is hard to tell them apart.

Neptune Base itself is huge; more than a mile in length and width. It is made of two buildings, one having the offices, communications, radar, and the like, and the other has the quarters, hangers for both fighters and shuttlecraft, repair stations, and hovercraft bays. They are connected by two main tunnels above ground and numerous ones below. They are separate because each time a major ship comes in, keeping its engines on full blast so it is not pulled into the planet, it shakes the building quite hard, which could wreck sensitive equipment if it had any. The generators that reduce the gravity, keep the buildings warm and supplied with air, and make the shields, are gigantic, taking up the lowest level of both buildings, but even then they are not big enough. In times of war, when the shields (one shield per building) must have all the ions they can get (the shields, which only stop radiation beams, like lasers and ion cannons), work by sending out hydrogen ions (alpha particles) which are able to absorb most of the blast. Highly polished surfaces do the rest. They turn off the heat, gravity reduction and air circulation to the building within the hangers.

The depot is a dome-shaped building which houses spares, defective things, and tries to invent new things. It is about ten miles from the base, and has almost as big generators, even though it has a diameter of less than a thousand feet. Both buildings are well defended with huge cannons and hundreds of little laser guns (guns which shoot out an amazing amount of lasers, although the ones on ships generally only have seven to ten). In addition, Neptune Base has over 600 Vensteds and 100 Helmans, which we will be discussing another month. **W**
