She spoke at the radio pick-up.

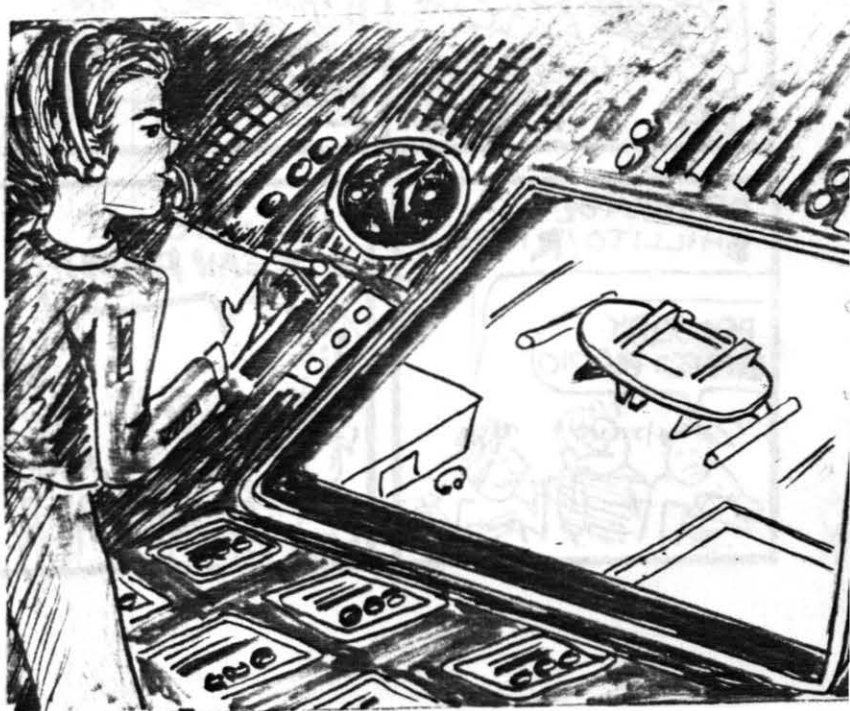
