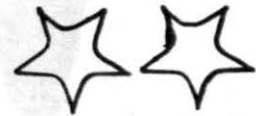

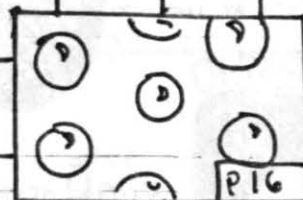

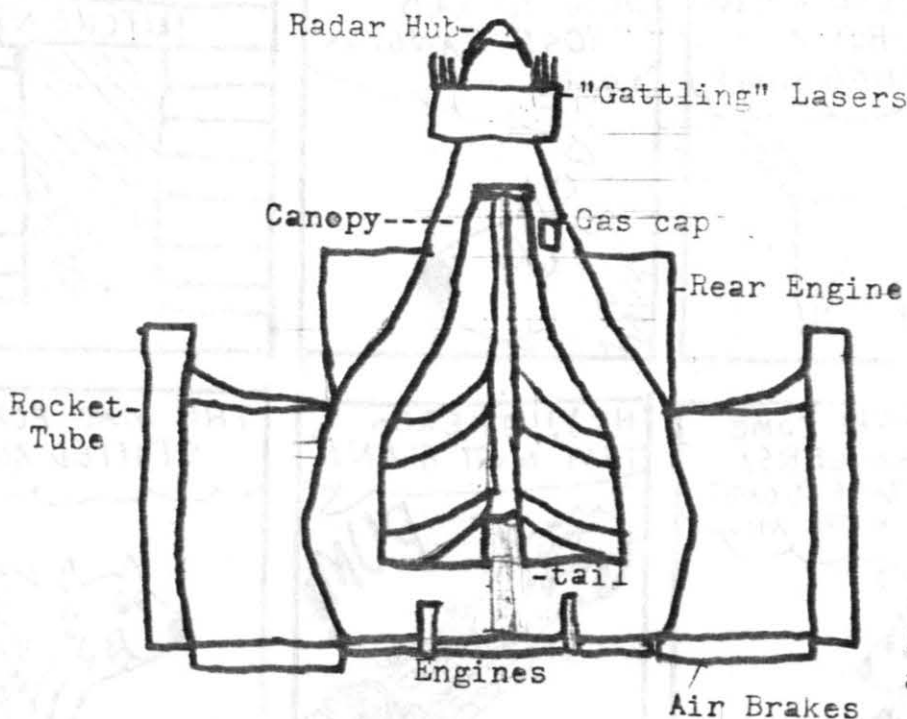
"Sure Benji," he replied, "We also have a couple of Hellmans and a Hornet being readied for stranded crews as well. They'll be ready

Again, the plane shifting increased. The ship completed a circuit around the Earth in 45 minutes and descended once again to rest on the California pad.

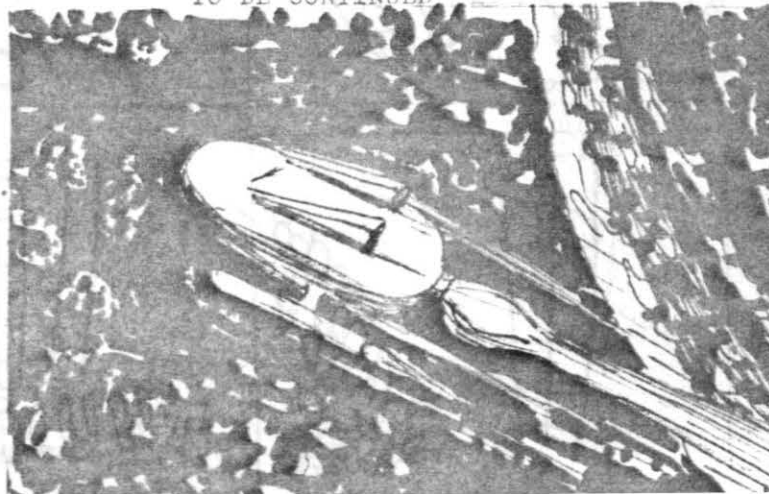
Pressure was released, and the hydrogen/helium gas mixture was released into holding tanks for separation and cooling.

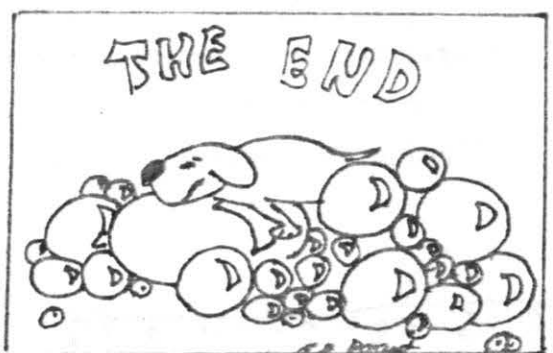
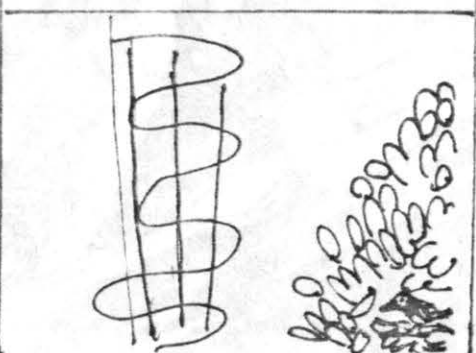
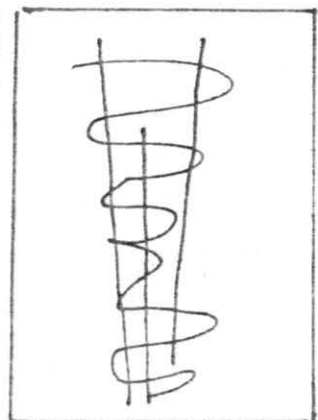
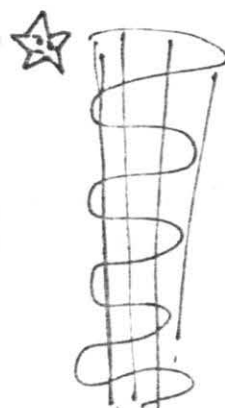
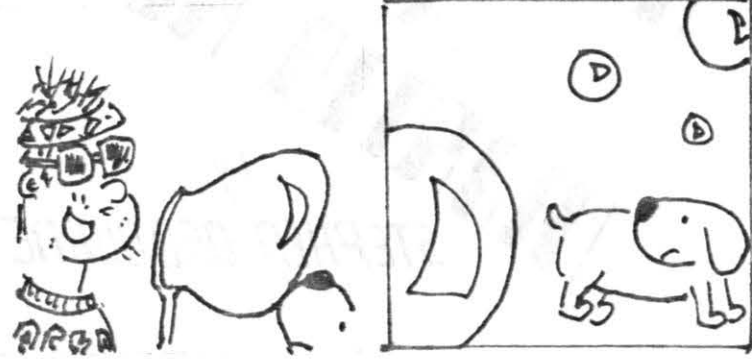
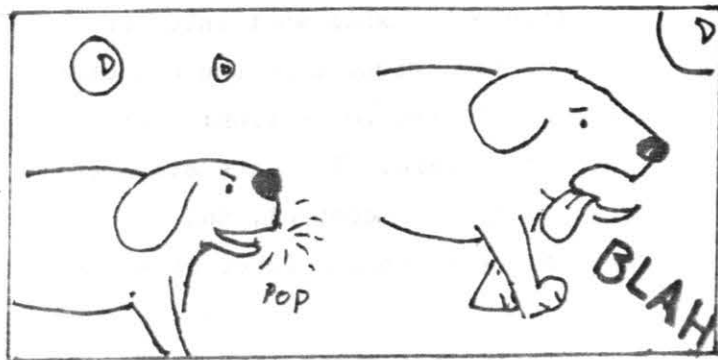
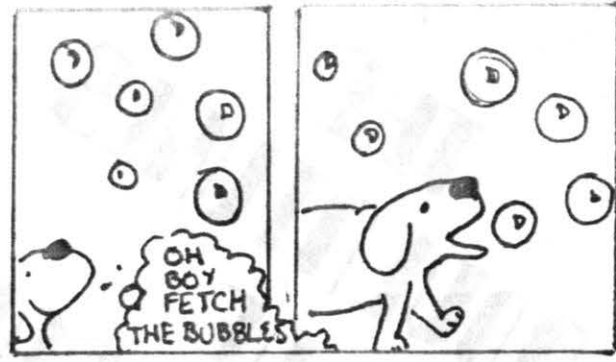
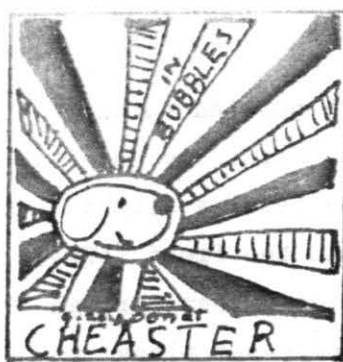
Martin and Marie unsealed themselves and clambered outside to stand on the unloading ramp. Martin raised his hands in victory.

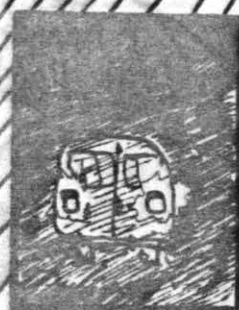
